Documents Required For Admission/Withdrawal

- Date of Birth Certificate from the CMO or any other competent authority as per the Government rules.
- Original Transfer Certificate from a school affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education. (SRN Should be written on the TC)
- Copy of Aadhar Card duly selfattested by the parents (Student and both the parent)
- 4) Original Transfer Certificate duly countersigned by the District Education Officer in respect of students coming from other recognized/ unrecognized private schools. (SRN Should be written on the TC)
- Two passport size photographs of both the parents and student each.
- Copy of report card of last class attended.



For withdrawal from the school following rules are to be considered:-

- If the conduct or influence of any student is detrimental to the general discipline. Then the Principal may order for immediate withdraw.
- 2) If fees and other dues are not deposited after issue of a reminder the student's name will be struck Off from the rolls of the school.
- If a student is found medically unfit and is a health hazard to other students. he/she may be withdrawn.
- 4) All students are admitted with an understanding that they win remain in the school for the entire course. Parents' guardians are not allowed to withdraw their children on any account except revision of fees, transfer. etc. In such cases one month notice should be given in writing.
- 5) The school leaving certificate will be issued only after the clearance of the dues. In addition Rs. 200/will be charged for the transfer certificate.

- Collect the detailed information from the school's front office.
- Confirm your feasibility to follow the school rules and regulation.
- 3. Fill the registration form to appear in the written test in H i n d i , E n g l i s h & Mathematics by depositing the registration form fee of Rs. 100/-
- A written test will be conducted on every Friday at 10:00 a.m. sharp.
- 5. School will declare the results of written exam on every Monday.


- 6. After clearing the written test the parents must deposit fee within 2 days of the declaration of result otherwise the seat will be allotted to the next eligible candidate, after meeting with the principal alongwith the student for final approval.

- Mere registration does not grantee admission.
